

CANDIDATES BOOTH SET UP REGULATED

Karaikal : As per Election Commission of India directives no Polling Booth shall be set up by any Candidates within a radius of 200 Meters of Polling Station. Only one booth by a candidate in a polling station having a set up of one table and two chairs, with an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin to cover the occupants from weather conditions will be allowed to establish outside the 200 meter periphery. Such booth shall not be enclosed by tentage.

The Candidates wishing to set up booths shall intimate the Returning Officers and also obtain necessary permission from Municipalities and Local bodies. The Permission obtained should be available with the persons manning the booth. Only one banner to display the name of the candidate, party or Election Symbol with the dimension not more than 3x4 1/2 feet in length and breadth will be allowed to put up. No crowd will be allowed to collect in front of the booth. Electors already cast their votes should not go to these booth after casting their vote. The person manning the booth shall not cause any obstructions to electors proceeding to booth or of other candidates or create any sort of hurdles.

Unofficial slips issued to electors from these booths can contain only the serial number and part number of the elector as per the photo E – roll of the polling stations. In no case, such unofficial slips should contain name of the candidate, election symbol, photograph etc of the candidate or party.
